NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SEALED BIDS FOR THE FOLLOWING CONTRACT
ENTITLED:

PROVISION OF DIESEL FUEL

will be received by the Borough of Brielle at Borough Hall on August 24th, 2023 at 10:00am prevailing time and will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids submitted prior to this time must be submitted to Mrs. Carol Baran Borough Clerk, Borough of Brielle, 601 Union Lane, Brielle, New Jersey 08730. Deviation from this submittal procedure will subject the proposal to rejection.

The work of this contract includes, but is not necessarily limited to the following:

Provision of 50,000 gallons, more or less, of Diesel Fuel
during each contract year.

Bid Forms, contracts, plans and specifications may be obtained during normal business hours from the Borough Clerk, 601 Union Lane, Brielle NJ 08730. (Specify fee, if any, to be nonrefundable) All bid proposals must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, bearing on the outside the name of the bidder, his address, and the name of the project for which the bid is submitted. Materials to be contained within the sealed envelope are specified in the General Specifications. Bid proposals shall be complete, in ink, and any bids incomplete or not submitted in a sealed, specially addressed envelope, or bids containing erasures not properly initialed will be considered informal and may be subject to rejection.

The bid proposal shall be accompanied by Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond, Cashier's Check or Certified- Check in the amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the full amount of the bid, or \$20,000, whichever is less. Bid Bond, Cashier's Check or Certified Check shall be made payable to the Borough of Brielle and shall be without condition or qualification.

The bid proposal shall also be accompanied by a Certificate from a Surety Company, authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey, and in a form acceptable to the Borough, stating that it will provide the bidder/contractor with any and all bonds required by the General Specifications.

All bidders shall be required to comply with Chapter 127, P.L. 1975, requiring each bidder and each subcontractor to formulate and submit to the proper authorized representative of the State of New Jersey, an affirmative action program of equal opportunity which guarantees minorities employment in all categories.

All bidders are further required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10.5-31 and N.J.A. C. 17:27 et seq.

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The Borough reserves the right to waive any informalities or minor irregularities in the Bids, or to reject any and all bids, if it is in the public interest to do so.

If the Bidder is a corporation or a partnership, the Bidder, in conformance with Chapter 33, P.L. 1977, shall submit with his bid, a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders in the Corporation or Partnership who own 10 percent or more of its stock, of any class or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10 percent or greater interest therein, as the case may be.

All bidders shall be required to comply with all applicable Federal, State and Municipal statutes, laws, ordinances, rules and regulations affecting the proposed public work. The insertion of any specific law or laws in this Advertisement for bias or other Contract Documents shall not be deemed as any limitation or enumeration of all the applicable laws concerning the proposed public work. Each and every provision of the law and clause required by any Federal, State or Municipal law to be inserted in this Advertisement for Bias or other Contract Documents shall be read and enforced as though the said laws were included therein.
