Mayor Nicol announced that this meeting was being held virtually in compliance with Executive Order No. 103 and was being recorded. There being no need for a work session the Mayor began the Regular Meeting.

Mayor Nicol read the compliance statement and the Regular Council Meeting was opened, after a pledge of allegiance to our flag. Mayor Nicol asked for a roll call.

Mayor Nicol then asked for a motion to approve the Minutes of the January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Regular Meeting. A motion was made by Councilman Gianforte seconded by Councilman Garruzzo, all aye, no nays. Passed.

Councilman Garruzzo cited the promotion of Sergeant Brian Stahl. Brian was raised by his parents Karl and Marianne Stahl in Point Pleasant. Brian served with the 430<sup>th</sup> Military Police Unit in Afghanistan and holds an associate degree in Criminal Justice from Ocean County College. Sergeant Stahl began his career with Brielle in May 2013 as a Class II Special having graduated from the Monmouth County Police Academy. In November 2013 he became a Patrolman, during which time he also served as the K-9 handler and Evidence Officer. Sergeant Stahl is currently the liaison to the Special Needs Registry and a squad leader on the Monmouth County Rapid Deployment Force. He resides in Point Pleasant with his wife Amanda and baby Riley.

Councilman Gorham had no report.

Councilman Shaak applauded the DPW department for their fantastic work during the two recent snow events. He mentioned several equipment issues that made the plowing a bit more challenging. Also, he reminded residents to remove their cars from roadways during inclement weather.

# Resolution to amend the 2021 Temporary Budget

Whereas, on December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 the Borough of Brielle did adopt a Temporary Budget for calendar year 2021, and

Whereas, said budget was in the amount of \$2,690, 342.27 representing less than \$2,703,125.01, the 25% of the 2020 Municipal Budget, permitted to be utilized by Local Budget Law, and

Whereas, said Temporary Budget was memorialized by the Governing Body at their Organization Meeting held on January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021, and

Whereas, the adopted budget contained an appropriation of \$40,000.00 for the Brielle Library, but said appropriation is no longer sufficient for their needs.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Library Appropriation be hereby increased to \$50,000.00 and that the \$10,000.00 increase shall be offset by a decrease of a like sum of \$10,000.00 from the Buildings & Grounds Appropriation.

Resolution No.: 21-32-E Date: February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Resolution authorizing the County of Monmouth Mosquito Control Division to conduct aerial mosquito control operations within the Borough of Brielle

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:9-27 et seq. has elected through its Mosquito Control Division to perform all acts necessary for the elimination of mosquito breeding areas and/or to exterminate mosquitoes within the county; and

WHEREAS, the County has instituted an Integrated Pest Management Program consisting of surveillance, water management, biological control, and chemical control to exterminate the mosquito population within the county of Monmouth; and

WHEREAS, prior to conducting aerial dispensing operations over a designated "congested area," the County is required, pursuant to Federal Aviation Administration Regulation (FAR Part 137.51), to secure prior written approval from the governing body of the political subdivision over which the aircraft is to be operated; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Brielle is designated as a "congested area" by the Federal Aviation Administration and the County has requested that this governing body consent to its proposed aerial dispensing operations.

## NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

- 1. The Governing Body hereby authorizes the County of Monmouth Mosquito Control Division or its agent to apply pesticides by aircraft for mosquito control in certain areas of the municipality designated by the County as being either larval mosquito habitat or areas harboring high populations of mosquitoes constituting either a nuisance, a health hazard, or both with the understanding that:
  - a. the County shall utilize pesticides, application equipment and aircraft that are approved for aerial applications by the applicable Federal (USEPA) and State (NJDEP) agencies, and
  - b. such operations will be performed in compliance with applicable Federal and State regulations, and
  - c. the County will notify the police department of each municipality over which aerial pesticide operations are planned prior to commencement of such operations.
